[wma international code of medical ethics](#) Oct 23 2019 26 10 2022 the international code of medical ethics should be read as a whole and each of its constituent paragraphs should be applied with consideration of all other relevant paragraphs consistent with the mandate of the wma the code is addressed to physicians the wma encourages others who are involved in healthcare to adopt these ethical principles
